Routes 46 and 80 WEST to Route 287 SOUTH; Route 287 SOUTH to Route 78 WEST to Exit 26- Lamington/North Branch. Left at stop light. Cross over Route 78 on Rattlesnake Bridge Road to Fiddler's Elbow Country Club- immediately on the right.

FROM NEWARK AIRPORT

Route 78 to Exit 26- Lamington/North Branch. Left at stop light. Cross over Route 78 on Rattlesnake Bridge Road to Fiddler's Elbow Country Club-immediately on right.

FROM WILMINGTON AND PHILADELPHIA

New Jersey Turnpike NORTH to Exit 10-Route 287 NORTH: Route 287 NORTH to Route 78 WEST; Route 78 WEST to Exit 26- Lamington/North Branch. Left at stop Light. Cross over Route 78 on Rattlesnake Bridge Road to Fiddler's Elbow Country Club- immediately on right.

FROM NEW YORK CITY (two options)

George Washington Bridge and Route 80 WEST to Route 287 SOUTH; Route 287 SOUTH to Route 78 WEST to Exit 26- Lamington/North Branch. Left at stop light. Cross over Route 78 on Rattlesnake Bridge Road to Fiddler's Elbow Country Club- immediately on right.

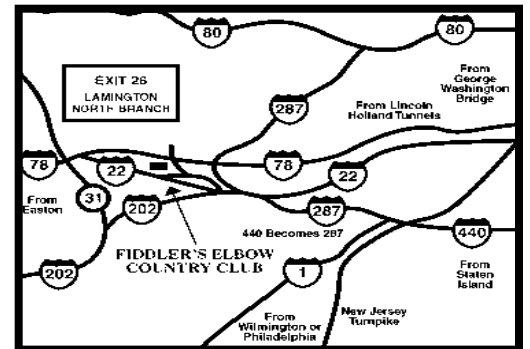
